





- The Joint Commission
  - UH has been awarded a three-year reaccreditation.
- The Heart Failure program was awarded a two-year reaccreditation.

- LGBTQ
  - UH has been recognized by the Human Rights Campaign as a 'Top Performer' in its Healthcare Equality Index.
  - The Index recognizes LGBTQ-inclusive patient, visitation, and employment policies.






## Accolades

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- UH is the only hospital in New Jersey awarded Gold Plus recognition by the American Heart Association for Heart Failure and Stroke, Target Honor Roll status for advanced heart failure, and Honor Roll-Elite Plus for stroke.
- The UH Emergency Services Department achieved the highest ranking – Gold Plus – from the American Heart Association’s Mission: Lifeline program.
- UH was one of only 68 hospitals nationally awarded ‘Meritorious’ status for our outcomes in eight surgical areas by the American College of Surgeons.
- The American Hospital Association awarded UH ‘Most Wired’ for the quality of our Information Technology capabilities, one of only 461 hospitals nationally to achieve the designation.

## Floors F through I: Nursing Units and Diagnostic/Procedure Areas

**F** - Pediatrics, Labor & Delivery, Nurseries, Adult Med-Surg Unit

**G** – Inpatient Psychiatry, Neuro ICU, Adult Med-Surg Unit, Neuro Testing

**H** – Observation Unit, Med-Surg Units, Nuclear Medicine, Interventional Radiology

**I** – Medical ICU, CCU, Telemetry, Cardiac Cath, EKG, Cardiac Stress Testing

**J** – Roof/Heliport


